

A+ for the Snowpark Gastein setup!

If they existed, the Snowpark Gastein would certainly get an AAA by the rating agencies of freestyle: A snowboard and freeski team has tested the park last week and graded it with an A+.

The last few weeks also the Snowpark Gastein got a lot of snow, so the whole park crew had enough material available to serve a special class setup to all freestylers! The park was tested by six freeski and snowboard pros like Victor Szigety and Moritz Schwarz and the entire team has graded the park with an A+! Blue bird sky and a perfectly shaped park - a start to the session as it couldn't be better!

Park designer Jonas Ernst and his crew shaped the park to the most: namely, day and night! For the start of the shooting session, the last weekend 6 freestyle pros and the shred community in the Snowpark Gastein was offered a creative set-up with a great variety of elements:

The park offered **4 kickers with 2-4m tables, 6 different boxes between 3 and 15 m length, 5 butter boxes** in the medium range, **2 downrails with 11m length, a 8m long kink rail** and a **6m long tube!**

An extensive setup at the start of the season! And that wasn't all, because at the moment the crew is working on the **pro kicker line with 7-12m tables!**
